

What is Energy Wheeling?

Wheeling, also known as "Power Wheeling" or "Electricity Wheeling" is the transportation of electrons from one location, through the national power grid, to another location. Wheeling is essentially a financial transaction whereby Eskom electrons are swapped out with renewable energy electrons supplied by Apollo Africa through the use of a Power Purchase Agreement (PPA).

What is a PPA?

A Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) represents a contractual agreement between Apollo Africa and a commercial electricity buyer. Under the agreement, the business commits to buying a specific quantity of electricity from a renewable energy generator, such as a wind or solar farm.
